BSR Realty Inc. "We Care" Project

In 1994 long time BSR Realty employee Barbara Moniz had a wonderful Christmas-giving idea. Having befriended many hardworking and generous people while working at BSR she devised a plan to collect donations from their list of local vendors, property owners and employees and use the donation money to purchase local families in need items from their Christmas lists, which she happily named the "We Care" project.

Since its inception the "We Care" project, has helped purchase and deliver items to over 425 adopted families in southern Alameda County a total of more than \$100,000 in clothes, toys and food for Christmas dinner.

"We Care" acquires the names of families in need from local community organizations including the Salvation Army, All Saints Church, and FESCO. Each family is asked to submit a Christmas List of items they both need and desire.

Shopping lists are created for each of the families full of clothing, toys and a Safeway gift card so that each family member will have a gift to open and a warm meal to look forward to over the holidays.


